PUBLIC HEARINGS

- PH-1 **PUBLIC HEARING** scheduled this day pursuant to action of the Council on February 8, 2011, under the State law, public notice having been inserted in the local press by the City Clerk, to hear comments on the conveyance of two City-owned parcels of land located on **the East and West sides of the “Old” 24th Bay Street in East Beach** to Norfolk Redevelopment and Housing Authority.

- R-1 Matter of a letter from the City Manager and an Ordinance entitled, “An Ordinance permitting **Pretty Lake Development, LLC**, to encroach into city property and Pretty Lake Avenue, a paper street, in the **4100 and 4200 blocks of Pretty Lake Avenue**, with a six-foot (6’) wide wooden community pier,” will be introduced in writing and read by its title.
